# FAQ's for CMN Students

### **Housing Contract?**

All housing contracts are for **2 semesters**

### **Room Deposits?**

A \$150.00 deposit is required for all new single students

A \$500.00 deposit is required for all students in family housing

### **Families?**

Married students who choose to live on campus must:

- Provide copy of marriage certificate
- Have no more than 2 children
- Children must be under 12 years of age

### **Non-Traditional Students?**

Single students who wish to be considered for Non-Traditional housing must:

- Be at least 25 years of age or older
- Receive background check
- Interview with the Director of Residential Life

### **Policies and Rules?**

Click on Resident Handbook and also on Students Rights and Responsibilities. Below is an overview of policies and rules all residents must follow.

- Students have the responsibility to know and adhere to rules and regulations of the University and Residential Life...
- Residents must respect the rights of others...
- Students are expected to contribute positively to the community by participating in educational and developmental activities...
- Residents are responsible for keeping their own rooms in a reasonably clean...
- Successful residence hall living depends on the understanding of different lifestyles and respect for your room mate...
- Because of liability, legal issues, and the inconvenience to other residents, babysitting is not permitted in the residence hall...
- Routine maintenance in the residence halls is provided...
- The Residential Life staff, its agents and employees, shall have the right to enter any room or apartment...

- The possession or consumption of beer or intoxicating liquors anywhere in the residence halls, on the campus grounds, or in the campus buildings is forbidden by state law and university policy...
- Overnight guests must be the same gender and approval must be granted by the Director of Residential Life...
- Visitors and guests under the age of 18 are not permitted...
- Students have the responsibility to monitor and accept responsibility for the behavior of guests...
- Occasionally staff members, Community Assistants and Desk Attendants must confront residents to remind them of various policies...
- OSU Institute of Technology endeavors to assure that individuals are treated fairly without regard to race, national origin, religion, sexual orientation or physical limitation...
- Smoking is prohibited on the CMN and OSUIT campuses except where designated via the OSUIT Housing Office
- All fireworks, firearms, and dangerous weapons (including knives), swords, explosives, ammunition (including blanks and hand-load components), bull whips, bow and arrows, darts, metal knuckles, clubs, blackjacks, air guns, paint ball guns, BB guns, or any other offensive or defensive weapons are prohibited from all the residence hall facilities...

### **Room Furnishings?**

All rooms are completely furnished. Furniture cannot be removed or traded. There is no storage space available for students' belongings. Furniture included in each room is listed below:
